Calf Scramble Rules and Regulations

- 1. Participant must be a 2025 registered Livestock Exhibitor, high school student, <u>and</u> a member in good standing with Jackson County 4-H or FFA.
- 2. Entry Fee is \$25 per participant. Entry fee is non-refundable.
- 3. Cash awards will be given as a reimbursement of Livestock Exhibitor expenses on their 2024 Livestock Project. Applicable receipts will have to be turned in to redeem the cash award. The 1st participant who catches and brings a calf across the line will be awarded a **belt buckle** along with a \$600.00 cash reimbursement price. The 2nd place \$400.00 cash reimbursement price and 3rd place \$200.00 cash reimbursement price.
- 4. Parent or legal guardian must sign in the presence of a notary, the "consent for minor to participate" portion of the Jackson County Calf Scramble Entry form.
- 5. Incomplete entry forms will not be accepted.
- 6. Completed entry forms must be mailed to the Jackson County Youth Fair, PO Box 457, Edna, TX 77957, no later than Tuesday, October 7th, or turned in to Fair Office at BRC, to be considered eligible to participate in the calf scramble.
- 7. Number of Scramblers to scramble will be at the committee's discretion.
- 8. All scramble contestants and parents/legal guardians must attend Mandatory "Roll Call" and meeting at 5:45 p.m. in the Meeting Room located near the BRC Main Office on October 10th.
- 9. Calf Scramble participants will go to the Main Arena as a group.

The JCYF Calf Scramble Committee reserves the authority to determine number of eligible participants, calves and awards.

The Jackson County Youth Fair and its members will not be responsible for any accident that may occur to any participant in the Calf Scramble; before, during, or after the Jackson County Youth Fair.

BRC Main Arena JCYF Calf Scramble Rules

- 1. Participants must wear appropriate attire and running shoes. No jewelry.
- 2. Participants will be using rope halters that are supplied by the JCYF Calf Scramble Committee.
- 3. Halters cannot be used as a lariat.
- 4. Halters must be placed on the head of the animal in the usual way. (It is suggested that the supervisors of all participants instruct them of the proper use of rope halter and how to place it on the head of calf before coming to the show to participate in the scramble).
- 5. At no time will participants be permitted, to tie the rope/halter to his/her body or belt.
- 6. Each participant will attempt to catch and halter one of the calves released.
- 7. The participant catching a calf is required to lead it across the finish line without aide.
- 8. If a participant has hold of a calf, no other participants will be allowed to touch the calf until it breaks away.
- 9. If a participant catches the calf by the tail, he or she will be allowed a reasonable amount of time to work around to the calf's head: otherwise, the referee/committeeman will order them to let the calf go.
- 10. If two or more participants catch the same calf, the calf will be turned lose.
- 11. A participant who secures and properly halters a calf and leads it across the finish line will be a winner, when so indicated by the committee/referee.
- 12. Undue roughness will not be allowed.
- 13. Poor sportsmanship automatically disqualifies scramble contestant.
- 14. All Jackson County Youth Fair Calf Scramble winners will take pictures with sponsors and other winners immediately following Calf Scramble contest at Photo area next to stage.
